

Webinar 6 Antibiotics in children - Learning Outcomes

By undertaking this webinar, participants will have increased:

- understanding that most parents are seeking reassurance and advice about their children, not necessarily antibiotics.
- 2. understanding that clinical uncertainty and fear of 'missing the sick child' leads to

inappropriate antibiotic prescribing.

- 3. understanding that the absolute risk to any individual child of having an invasive bacterial infection is very low.
- 4. intention to elicit and address parents' real concerns, and expectations.
- 5. intention to share written materials such as the "When Should I worry booklet "and the child-cough TARGET leaflet to support better communication with parents.
- 6. intention to reflect on your communication strategies with parents.
- 7. intention to use the STARWAVe tool to inform children's' risk of hospitalisation.
